

## TANDRIDGE CANOE & KAYAK CLUB Suzy Boat Loan Scheme

### Objectives

- To offer an affordable scheme for first year members, charging a small sum for wear and tear.
- To enable members to store a boat at home and use the same boat regularly in their first year without the inconvenience of hiring and collecting kit each time they paddle.
- To give members an opportunity to try different types of paddling (eg slalom, freestyle, whitewater) in their first paddling year before buying a boat of their own. Canoe Polo section members are encouraged to bring their loan plastic kayaks to polo sessions for additional practice.

### The Loan Scheme

- KAYAK: A deposit will be charged at the beginning of the loan and will be returned at the end of the year, less a sum for wear and tear. In 2009 & 2010 the charges are:  
**Deposit of £200 for plastic kayak. £180 returned after 1 year (ie £20 annual wear and tear fee)**  
**Deposit of £300 for slalom kayak. £220 returned after 1 year (ie £80 annual wear and tear fee)**
- KAYAK KIT: A further fixed deposit of £50 will be charged for the loan of any or all of the following items (subject to availability): paddle, spraydeck, buoyancy aid, cagoule, helmet. This deposit will be returned at the end of the year minus £30 (these items wear out more quickly than kayaks).
- A MAXIMUM deposit of £300 per family will be charged for one or more plastic kayaks.  
A MAXIMUM deposit of £400 per family will be charged for one or more slalom kayaks.  
However, the annual wear and tear fee applies to each Kayak and set of Kayak Kit borrowed.

### Conditions

1. **Usage: The kayak and kit should be used on a regular basis, at least monthly.**  
Before you sign up for the scheme we will check that you have and know how to use the correct equipment - roof bars and straps, padding (for slalom kayaks) etc.  
**You should read the "Kayaking in Safety" guidance notes, which are downloadable from the website.**
2. **Storage:** To qualify for the scheme, you must be able to **keep the Kayak and Kayak Kit securely and under cover** (out of sunlight) as extreme temperatures and sunlight make boats brittle.
3. **Care, condition / damage: You must look after the kit and undertake all minor repairs.** At the end of the loan period, you must hand all items back in an acceptable condition (e.g. fittings all sound and secure, leaks attended to, tears or holes in spraydecks repaired with Black Witch or similar).  
**Additional sums may be deducted from your deposit if kit has not been looked after.**
4. **Loss, fire or theft: If for whatever reason you are unable to return the equipment upon demand, you will be required to replace with equivalent kit OR repay the replacement value of boat and kit to the Club.** The replacement value is shown on the agreement and may be significantly higher than the deposit.
5. **Availability:** You have first priority over the use of the boat and kit during the Loan Period. However, if you are not using it, the equipment must be made available to other club members for trips etc. **This means that if you are away for more than two weeks, it is your responsibility to give the Loan Scheme Organiser advance notice.** When you lend this kit to others, provided you ask the borrower to complete a kit loan form, the primary loan and all of its conditions are suspended. If the Club has requested that loan kit is stored or used at a club-defined site or event for use by multiple paddlers, then the primary loan and all of its conditions are suspended for the duration of the storage and/or event. **When you lend your club loan kit to others, you must transfer responsibility to the other person by asking them to complete a single use kit loan form, downloadable from [www.tandridgecanoe.co.uk](http://www.tandridgecanoe.co.uk).**
6. **Period of agreement: The agreement is for 1 year only.** On an exceptional basis at the Club Committee's discretion, a new agreement may be set up after the first year, and only if other members do not require it. If a second year loan period is approved, you will make the annual wear and tear payments and sign a new agreement. Please return all equipment for inspection before signing the paperwork.
7. **Early termination of agreement:** the Club Committee may terminate the agreement at any time if the spirit of the loan scheme is not being honoured. You may terminate the agreement earlier than year end if the club has cash available to repay the deposit.
