We are very pleased to welcome you to our active junior canoe club.

Here's how to join:

- Step 1** Call or email the Leader (Blades/TYKs) or League Secretary (Canoe Polo) of the section you wish to join to check availability and your son/daughter's eligibility (age, ability, etc)
- Step 2** Join the Club: complete one Membership Form per family member, plus one parent/guardian consent form for each under-18 member of your family applying
- Step 3** Give your Membership Form to your Section Leader with the £5 Annual Family Membership Fee plus section fee if applicable. Cheques payable to TCKC.
- Step 4** You receive a Club Membership Card, entitling you to participate in activities in any Section of the Club.

Coaches have the right to prevent you from participating if they do not have a completed & signed Membership Form, Parent Consent Form & Fee from you.

A lot is asked of our Coaches in trying to run activities for young people as safely as possible. Please help them by lending a hand whenever you can, by accepting their safety advice and by following the Club's guidelines.

This is a voluntary Club that is run by the membership. Everyone, including coaches, is a volunteer, giving their time for free. Most of us have taken up the sport in the last 10 years and we are still learning. The success of the Club relies upon everyone giving a little of their time to help – examples of assistance that we need are:

- organising accommodation for trips

This cover extends to all Club members and helpers. It also gives Club juniors (but not adults):

- Access to all non-competitive BCU events
- Access to ranking competitions at entry level
- The right not to pay BCU membership fees at BCU events

Canoe Polo:

- Meets on Sunday evenings at Tandridge Leisure Pool, 6 – 8pm
- Get a team of 5 people together and come along on Sundays
- You do not need to know how to canoe before you join
- The Development League meets fortnightly
- The Premier League meets fortnightly on alternate Sundays to the Development League
- You can follow this activity for 3 months or 6 months – remember that our season runs September to December and January to Easter

SKILLS SECTION

- There is a skills programme for “Umpiring and Refereeing”
- We can train you to be a Canoe Polo referee and you could help us out weekly or fortnightly at our games
- Our season is mid-September to mid-April, so covers the six months you have to follow your skill
- There may be opportunities to referee regional youth competitions

SERVICE SECTION

- **Lifesaving**
if you are already training for a Lifesaving Qualification, you also need to give some practical service for your D of E Award. Tandridge Canoe Polo League needs poolside volunteers to assist with lifesaving duties at Tandridge Leisure Pool on Sunday evenings from 6 - 8pm. You can choose to help weekly or fortnightly
